#### A wealth of Winter Activities

Situated in the heart of a magnificent recreational playground, the Castle Hill Ski Region offers a wealth of winter activities! With its mountains, rivers, lakes and forests, the region has something for everyone... and all within an easy 70 minute drive from Christchurch. Nestled in the Craigieburn Range are four excellent ski fields, ranging from the small club fields with their friendly "family" atmosphere and uncrowded slopes, to a larger commercial field with extensive lift facilities. Porter Heights Skifield, the closest commercial field to Christchurch, is just 15 minutes drive from Castle Hill Village.

#### Summer too!

Boasting one of the longest lift-served ski runs in the Southern Hemisphere, Porter Heights offers a wide variety of interesting and varied runs for all types of skier as well as spectacular views of the Southern Alps. Its lifts are modern and reliable, there is a wide range of "downhill" amenities and the field has excellent road access. Three club fields — Mount Cheeseman, Broken River and Craigieburn — are all within easy reach of Castle Hill Village.

The Castle Hill Ski Region is also a recreational haven for non skiers and summer visitors. Jet boating and rafting down the Waimakariri River... fishing for salmon and trout in nearby lakes and rivers... horse riding and trekking through some of New Zealand's most spectacular mountain scenery... tramping and walks in the bush-clad hills of the Craigieburn Forest Park... just some of the summer attractions in this unique area!

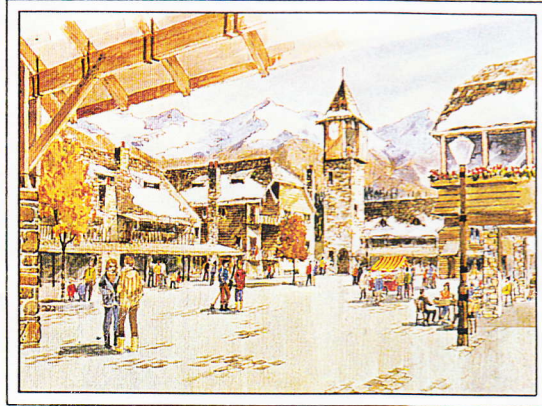


## CASTLE HILL VILLAGE

In the centre of the Castle Hill Ski Region, the new resort village of Castle Hill is being constructed. This will be the first totally-planned, alpine resort village built in New Zealand.

Historically, it was a stopping point for coaches en route to the West Coast goldfields once the first Hotel was built at Castle Hill in 1865.

Today freehold building sections are available in clustered neighbourhoods with architectural controls to ensure overall harmony of exterior design.



A picturesque lake is being created as a focal point with condominium units, clubhouse and tavern/restaurant built on the edge. The rest of the commercial buildings and lodges built of log and stone are clustered around a cobbled square. After dark a variety of restaurants, clubs and bars will offer a wide range of entertainments and menus.

Accommodation for owners of shops and restaurants will be provided in penthouse apartments in the building surrounding the square.

A diversity of attractions and amusements are being planned around the village to cater for all ages. Tennis and swimming will be available at the club and it is hoped to establish a golfcourse nearby.
